The works involves replacing of damaged doors and windows; rehabilitative works to roof structure and electrical works. The delivery/construction period is **eight (8) weeks**.

Bid Collection period is **Monday, April 21, 2008 to Friday, May 9, 2008 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Two Thousand Jamaican Dollars (JMD2,000.00) each in cash or certified cheque made payable to the Jamaica Social Investment Fund.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Monday, May 12, 2008 at 12:00 noon**. Electronic bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected.
