ELECTRICITY REGULARIZATION (PILOT) – ST. CATHERINE (071087)

1. The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the **INNER CITY BASIC SERVICES FOR THE POOR PROJECT**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the following Contracts:

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Electricity Regularization in St. Catherine**. The works involve supply and installation of electrical materials for approximately 100 households to regularize electrical supply with the Jamaica Public Service Company Limited and getting certification of the electrical works by Government Electrical Inspector. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

2. All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Electrical Works**” in **Grade 3 or higher Grades**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines and in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (May 2001), National Contracts Commission, Sections 3 and 6.

5. All Bidders must be tax compliant at bid opening. **The original Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) must be presented at the bid opening or within two (2) days of the bid opening.**

6. Bid Collection period is **Monday, January 14, 2008 to Thursday, February 14, 2008 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Two Thousand Jamaican Dollars (JMD2,000.00) each in cash or certified cheque made payable to the Jamaica Social Investment Fund.
7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Friday, February 15, 2008 at 12:00 noon.** Electronic bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically on **Friday, February 15, 2008** in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at **12:05 p.m.**
8. All bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One percent (1%) of the value of the Tender Sum.**
