1. The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the **HURRICANE DEAN EMERGENCY RECOVERY LOAN PROJECT**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the following Contracts:

BARNETT TO RETIREMENT ROAD - HURRICANE DEAN – ST. CATHERINE (#72040)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Barnett to Retirement Road – Hurricane Dean in St. Catherine**. The works involve clearing of the site and removal unwanted materials from site, placement and compaction of marl, construction of retaining wall, construction of drain, asphalt road surface and patch existing potholes and relocation of 100mm dia. water main. The delivery/construction period is **sixteen (16) weeks**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 2 or higher Grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

The works involve demolition of block work, wood louvre, roof covering, bathroom fixtures and ceiling hardboard and cart away from site, preparation and application of oil paint to metal roof frame, installation of alusteel roof covering, installation of roof gutter and down pipes, installation of ceiling hardboard, the supplying and installation of doors and door frames, repair defective electrical wiring and install electrical outlets painting of walls, ceiling and roof eave and installation of sanitary fittings. Installation of roof guttering and down pipe; installation of ceiling hardboard; installation of timber roof farming, installation of windows and doors, repair defective electrical, wiring and install electrical outlets, painting of walls and ceiling, patch concrete walkway, construction of concrete beam and supplying and installation of felt water proofing material to plywood sheeting. 7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Tuesday, July 15, 2008 at 12:00 noon**. Electronic bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected.
