#### **CLARKS TOWN ROAD REHABILITATION – HURRICANE DEAN - MANCHESTER**

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Clarks Town Road Rehabilitation – Hurricane Dean in Manchester**. The works involve the rehabilitation of 1.51km of road to include scarification, double surface dressing road resurfacing, minor base reconstruction works, patching and construction of kerb and channel drains. The delivery/construction period is **two (2) months**.

The works involve the rehabilitation of 0.85km of roadway including reinstatement of road base, double surface dressing road resurfacing; construction of culverts and kerb and channel drains. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

The works involve the rehabilitation of 1.51km of road to include patching, double surface dressing road resurfacing, minor reinstatement of road base; cleaning of culverts and construction of kerb and channel drains. The delivery/construction period is **two (2) months**.

The works involve the rehabilitation of 1.45km of road to include reinstatement of road base; rubble retaining wall, double surface dressing road resurfacing and construction of asphalt concrete cross drains. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines and in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (May 2001), National Contracts Commission, Sections 3 and 6.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Friday, March 7, 2008 at 12:00 noon**. Electronic bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically on **Friday, March 7, 2008** in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at **12:05 p.m.**

8. All bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One percent (1%) of the value of each Tender Sum.**
