#### **MAY PEN HEALTH CENTRE – HURRICANE DEAN - CLARENDON**

1. The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the **HURRICANE DEAN EMERGENCY RECOVERY LOAN PROJECT**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the following Contract:

2. The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **May Pen Health Centre Rehabilitation – Hurricane Dean in Clarendon**. The works involve Painting, termite treatment; installation of aluminum windows, floor and wall tiles; removal and installation of timber roof and drainage guttering system; installation of perimeter chain link fencing and concrete works to include floor and roof slabs, blockwalling and reinforced Concrete Columns. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines and in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (May 2001), National Contracts Commission, Sections 3 and 6.

5. All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category **“Building Construction ”** in **Grade 4 or higher Grades**. (See [www.ocg.gov.jm](http://www.ocg.gov.jm)).

6. All Bidders must be tax compliant at bid opening. **The original Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) must be presented at the bid opening or within two (2) days of the bid opening.**

7. Bid Collection period is **Monday, February 18, 2008 to Thursday, March 6, 2008 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Two Thousand Jamaican Dollars (JMD2,000.00) each in cash or certified cheque made payable to the Jamaica Social Investment Fund.

8. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Friday, March 7, 2008 at 12:00 noon**. Electronic bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically on **Friday, March 7, 2008** in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at **12:05 p.m.**

9. All bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One percent (1%) of the value of the Tender Sum.**
