1. The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the **EMERGENCY RECOVERY PROJECT**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the following Contracts:

GREEN FIELD RURAL FEEDER ROAD REHABILITATION - ST. ELIZABETH (#072143)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Green Field Rural Feeder Road Rehabilitation in St. Elizabeth**. The project involves the rehabilitation of 3.25km of roadway to include construction of V-Drain and U-Drain and rubble stonewall. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 2 or higher Grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Three Hundred and Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$315,000.00)**.

ROWLANDSFIELD ALL AGE SCHOOL – HURRICANE DEAN – ST. THOMAS (#071981)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Rowlandsfield All Age School – Hurricane Dean in St. Thomas**. The scope of the works involves repairs to damaged roof; painting; replacing damaged windows and doors; electrical repairs where necessary, upgrading of canteen facilities, installation of water tank and repairs to entrance to school. The delivery/construction period is **Three (3) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Building Construction**” in **Grade 4 or higher Grades**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One Hundred and Six Thousand Dollars (\$106,000.00)**.
