1. The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the **INNER CITY BASIC SERVICES FOR THE POOR PROJECT**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the following Contracts:

CENTRAL VILLAGE INTEGRATED INFRASTRUCTURE – PACKAGE- 1 – ANDREWS LANE – ST. CATHERINE (#72258)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for *Central Village Integrated Infrastructure - Package 1 – Andrews Lane in St. Catherine*. The scope of works consists of upgrading and reinstatement of infrastructure services (water supply, fire hydrants, storm water drainage and road works):

Road Works :

Construction of approximately 680m of roadway with asphaltic concrete surface of varying width.

Water Supply:

Installation of approximately 250m of 50mm dia PVC pipe. Lay approximately 570m of 100mm dia. PVC pipes. Installation of fire hydrants.

Stormwater Drainage:

Clearing of existing drains. Construction of new open concrete drains approximately 34m in length. Lay approximately 261m culvert pipes and construction of head walls.

The delivery/construction period is seven (7) months.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for *Central Village Integrated Infrastructure - Package 2 – Little Lane in St. Catherine*. The scope of works consists of upgrading and reinstatement of infrastructure services (water supply, fire hydrants, storm water drainage and road works):

Road Works :

Construction of approximately 460m of roadway with asphaltic concrete surface of varying width.

Water Supply:

Installation of approximately 1106m of 50mm dia PVC pipe. Lay approximately 972m of 100mm dia. PVC pipes. Installation of fire hydrants.

Stormwater Drainage:

Construction of new open concrete drains approximately 382m in length. Construct 1 No Inlet Manhole, Drain repairs; clearing of existing block wall drain.

The delivery/construction period is nine (9) months.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Central Village Integrated Infrastructure - Package 3 – Detriot in St. Catherine**. The scope of works consists of upgrading and reinstatement of infrastructure services (water supply, fire hydrants, storm water drainage and road works):

Road Works :

Construction of approximately 735m of roadway with asphaltic concrete surface of varying width.

Water Supply:

Installation of approximately 1486m of 50mm dia PVC pipe. Lay approximately 735m of 100mm dia. PVC pipes. Installation of fire hydrants.

Stormwater Drainage:

Clearing of existing drains. Construction of new open concrete drains approximately 240m in length. Lay approximately 397m culvert pipes and construction of head walls.

The delivery/construction period is **ten (10) months**.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Central Village Integrated Infrastructure - Package 4 – West Side in St. Catherine**. The scope of works consists of upgrading and reinstatement of infrastructure services (water supply, fire hydrants, storm water drainage and road works):

Road Works :

Construction of approximately 370m of roadway with asphaltic concrete surface of varying width.

Water Supply:

Installation of approximately 160m of 50mm dia PVC pipe. Lay approximately 366m of 100mm dia. PVC pipes. Installation of fire hydrants.

Stormwater Drainage:

Clearing of existing drains. Construct 6 no. inlet manholes. Lay approximately 420m culvert pipes and construction of head walls.

The delivery/construction period is **eight (8) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Civil Engineering**” and /or “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 2 or higher Grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Central Village Integrated Infrastructure - Package 5 – Big Lane in St. Catherine**. The scope of works consists of upgrading and reinstatement of infrastructure services (water supply, fire hydrants, storm water drainage and road works):

Road Works :

Construction of approximately 331m of roadway with asphaltic concrete surface of varying width.

Water Supply:

Installation of approximately 1300m of 50mm dia PVC pipe. Lay approximately 340m of 100mm dia. PVC pipes. Installation of fire hydrants.

Stormwater Drainage:

Clearing of existing drains. Construction of new open concrete drains approximately 510m in length..

The delivery/construction period is **nine (9) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Civil Engineering**” and /or “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 2 or higher Grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Central Village Main Drain in St. Catherine**. The scope of works consists of removal of all debris and silt from the existing drain, and remove from site, including cleaning sides and base drains. Repairing of existing block wall drain in localized sections.

The delivery/construction period is **four (4) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Civil Engineering**” and /or “**General Road Works**” in Grade 4 or higher Grades. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00)**.

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines and in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (November 2008), National Contracts Commission, Sub-Section No. S-2040

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Friday, September 18, 2009 at 12:00 noon.** Electronic bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically on **Friday, September 18, 2009** in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at **12:05 p.m.**
