The Government of Jamaica has received funding from the Caribbean Development Bank/Basic Needs Trust Fund Sixth Programme towards the cost of the Jamaica Social Investment Fund Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to cover payments under the following contracts:

Crawford Primary School Expansion and Rehabilitation – St. Elizabeth (#072534)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Crawford Primary School Expansion and Rehabilitation in St. Elizabeth**. The scope of works for the include construction of 3 classroom block, sanitation block, drainage system, perimeter fencing, new electrical installation works, asphalt concreted driveway/parking area, and football field. Renovation/rehabilitation works to the existing school structure will include the partitioning of classrooms, replacement of steel cladding concrete block walling, replacement of windows and doors, replacement of roof members and covering, the provision and installation of solar panels and water heater and painting of all structures. **The delivery/construction period is Eight (8) months.**

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 2 or higher grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Three Hundred and Forty Six Thousand Dollars (\$346,000.00)**.

Eric Malcolm Basic School Construction – St. Catherine (#072539)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Eric Malcolm Basic School Construction in St. Catherine**. The scope of works include construction of Three (3) classroom block each with external teaching area, principal’s Office, sick bay, students’ bathroom facility with disabled access. Construction of kitchen with pantry and bathroom facility for kitchen staff, covered corridor and fencing of play area. The delivery/construction period is **Five (5) Months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 2 or higher grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Three Hundred and Two Thousand Dollars (\$302,000.00)**.

Homestead Place of Safety Expansion and Upgrading – St. Andrew (#072400)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Homestead Place of Safety Expansion and Upgrading in St. Andrew**. The scope of works include the construction of a skills training centre, wash building, garbage area, parking area, handrails, drying yard, improvement to drainage, Improvement of storage areas, termite treatment and painting of all buildings. Renovation works include workshop and classroom, sewing room, main building, perimeter fence and water tank. **The delivery/construction period is four (4) months.**

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 2 or higher grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Four Hundred and Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$417,000.00)**.

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Litchfield Basic School Expansion and Fencing in Manchester**. The Scope of Works include the construction of chain link boundary fencing, play area, one (1) new classroom, sick bay area, lunchroom, ramps for disabled persons. Renovation/rehabilitation works include repairs to roof gutters, ceiling and partitioning. **The delivery/construction period is four (4) months.**

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 3 or higher grades**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Two Hundred and Nine Thousand Dollars (\$209,000.00)**.

Mocho Primary and Infant School Refurbishing and Fencing – Clarendon (#072476)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Mocho Primary and Infant School Refurbishing and Fencing in Clarendon**. The scope of works include construction of four (4) classrooms block, play area, sick bay, Kitchen, a courtyard, sanitation block, perimeter fence, the provision of solar water heater and solar panels and water storage facilities. Renovation/rehabilitation works to the existing building include expansion of infant department, replacement of decorative blocks to windows and the painting of all structures. **The delivery/construction period is six (6) months.**

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 2 or higher grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Three Hundred and Sixty Seven Thousand Dollars (\$367,000.00)**.

Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (Revised October 2010), Volume 2 of 4 Procedures for the Procurement of Goods, General Services & Works.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the bidding documents at the Jamaica Social Investment Fund at the address below from **8:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m.** Bid collection period **Wednesday, June 29, 2011 to Tuesday, July 19, 2011.** A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Two Thousand, Five Hundred Jamaican Dollars (JMD2,500.00)** for printed copy or **Five Hundred Jamaican Dollars (JMD500.00)** for Compact Disc (CD) in cash or certified cheque made payable to the Jamaica Social Investment Fund. **All bids must be submitted in printed copy. Original and Copy of the bid must be submitted in accordance with Instruction to Bidders.**

All bidders must be tax compliant at bid opening. **The original Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) must be presented at the bid opening or within two (2) days of the bid opening.**

Bids must be delivered to the address below by **12:00 noon on Wednesday, July 20, 2011.** Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at **12:05 p.m. on Wednesday, July 20, 2011.**
