The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the Caribbean Development Bank towards the cost of the **COMMUNITY INVESTMENT PROJECT**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to cover payments under the following contract:

Crystal City Sanitation Project - St. Thomas (#072502)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Crystal City Sanitation Project in St. Thomas**. The scope of the works involve the construction of bathroom facilities for twenty two (22) houses inclusive of: water closet, lavatory basin, shower and outdoor wash tub to assist in food preparation. The delivery/construction period is **four (4) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 3 or higher grades**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Two Hundred and Twenty Three Thousand Dollars (\$223,000.00)**.

Freemans Hall Primary & Infant School Sanitation Upgrade and Renovation – Trelawny (#072490)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Freemans Hall Primary & Infant School Sanitation Upgrade and Renovation in Trelawny**. The work involves the construction of a new sanitation block. Renovation of the existing school building to include installation of partitions for classrooms, new windows and doors, replacing the roof covering and reducing the height of the outer corridor wall and ramp ways to facilitate the physically challenged as well as the construction of a 156M long perimeter fence. The construction period is **three (3) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 2 or higher grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Two Hundred and Fifty Four Thousand Dollars (\$254,000.00)**.

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Sawyers Primary School Sanitation Upgrade and Renovation in Trelawny**. The work involves the construction of a new sanitation block. Renovation of the existing school building, to include installation of partitions, black boards, windows and doors, installation of cupboards to the

existing kitchen as well as the construction of a 129M long perimeter fence. The construction period is **three (3) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category “**Building Construction**” in **Grade 3 or higher grades**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Two Hundred and Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$215,000.00)**.

Wilsons Run Primary School Sanitation Upgrade and Renovation – Trelawny (#072491)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Wilsons Run Primary School Sanitation Upgrade and Renovation in Trelawny**. The work involves the construction of a new sanitation block. Expansion of upgraded kitchen facilities; construction of a multi-purpose half court and the paving of the entrance road way, construction of a 170M long perimeter fence. The construction period is **three (3) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category “**Building Construction**” in **Grade 2 or higher grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Water Wheel to Pleasant Hill Road Rehabilitation - Westmoreland (#072531)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Water Wheel to Pleasant Hill Road Rehabilitation in Westmoreland**. The work involves the rehabilitation of **1.8 km** of roadway, V-Drains; asphaltic and rip rap cross drains. The construction period is **three (3) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 2 or higher grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Two Hundred and Forty Six Thousand Dollars (\$246,000.00)**.

Original and Copy of the bid must be submitted in accordance with Instruction to Bidders.**

6. All bidders must be tax compliant at bid opening. **The original Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) must be presented at the bid opening or within two (2) days of the bid opening.**
