1. GENERAL INTRODUCTION

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF) is an autonomous government company established in December 1996 as a component of the Government of Jamaica’s strategy to reduce and eradicate poverty. JSIF is designed to provide investments in community-based projects island wide and is a demand-driven financial intermediary. It works in partnership with communities, the private sector, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and donor agencies, in seeking to channel benefits to the poorest communities across the country.

Background

The Government of Jamaica has received funding from the Caribbean Development Bank/Basic Needs Trust Fund Sixth Programme towards the cost of the Jamaica Social Investment Fund Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to cover payments under the following contract:

Scope of Work

1.1.1. Database upgrade & Documentation

1. Rationalize (i.e. normalization, index tuning, performance troubleshooting and query optimization) and migrate the current SQL Server 7.0 database to an SQL Server 2008 R2 database.
2. Build a Data Dictionary for the migrated SQL Server 2008 R2 database.
3. Develop technical documentation for the Database

1.1.2. Historical Database Creation

1. Design a logical & Physical data model for JSIF
2. Design and create with documentation a JSIF Historical database, with relevant fact and dimension tables.

1.1.3. BI Platform

1. Implement SSAS: Create an OLAP historical, predictive analysis and trend reporting database with the relevant cubes and dimensions.
2. Implement SSRS: configure report server and create report server database.

5. QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

- Minimum twelve years experience in information Technology, with at least eight years in Database Management Positions, and a minimum of three years focused on the Microsoft BI stack.
- Expert Knowledge in Database management Systems
- Tertiary level training in information Technology – (Minimum qualification B.Sc. Computer Science).
