#### **COMFORT BAPTIST BASIC SCHOOL - HURRICANE DEAN - CLARENDON (071894)**

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Comfort Baptist Basic School - Hurricane Dean in Clarendon**. The scope of the works involve the construction of a standard two (2) classroom with sanitary and kitchen facilities, administrative area all necessary sewer and drainage system and the construction of a perimeter fence. The delivery/construction period is **four (4) months**.

The scope of the works involve the construction of a two-storey six (6) classroom block. The delivery/construction period is **Six (6) months**.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Bog Walk to Lime Walk Road – Hurricane Dean in St. Catherine**. The scope of the works involve the paving of **2.6 km** of roadway with associated drainage features, 5200m of roadway bushing, 12,672 sq. m road paved (asphalt; 530 M “U” drain constructed; 8800 M “V” drain constructed; 65 cubic metre rubble stonewall constructed and 96 square metre rip rap drain. The delivery/construction period is **Three (3) months** .

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category **“General Road Works Construction”** in **Grade 2 or higher Grade**. (See [www.ocg.gov.jm](http://www.ocg.gov.jm)).
