FAIRY HILL HEALTH CENTRE – HURRICANE DEAN - PORTLAND (#071956)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Fairy Hill Health Centre Hurricane Dean in Portland**. The project involves rehabilitation of various aspects of the building. This includes upgrade to the electrical wiring and lighting, replacement of the roof and painting some areas of the building. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Building Construction**” in **Grade 4 or higher Grade**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00)**.

MANNINGS HILL ALL AGE SCHOOL REHABILITATION – HURRICANE DEAN - ST. ANDREW (#072115)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Mannings Hill All Age School Rehabilitation - Hurricane Dean in St. Andrew**. The works involve removal and replacing of damaged ceiling materials on main block, removal and repair of damaged windows and doors. Conducting of electrical repairs (inclusive of partial rewiring and the protecting of exposed wiring), fitting of shelves for the food storage area of canteen; general repairs to plumbing fixtures. Restoration of a proper surface drainage, this area will be used also for the construction of Netball Court/sporting facility. Rehabilitation and erection of front perimeter fence. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Building Construction**” in **Grade 4 or higher Grades**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

MANGO ROW ROAD REHABILITATION – HURRICANE DEAN - ST THOMAS (#071930)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Mango Row Road Rehabilitation – Hurricane Dean in St. Thomas**. The scope of the Works involve the paving of **3.2 km** of roadway (partly Double Surface Dressing and Asphalt), the construction of 2,300 m² drain and 80 cubic meters of rubble stonewall. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 2 or higher grade**.(See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **Two Hundred and Seventy Three Thousand Dollars (\$273,000.00)**.

OXFORD ROAD REHABILITATION- HURRICANE DEAN - ST THOMAS (#071932)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Oxford Road Rehabilitation - Hurricane Dean in St. Thomas**. The scope of works involve repair to 2.8 km of roadway using combination of Double Surface Dressing and Asphalt, the construction of 1950 m V drain, 30 cubic meters of rubble wall and 80 cubic meters of rubble stonewall. The delivery/construction period is **three (3) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 3 or higher grade**.(See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One Hundred and Seventy Seven Thousand Dollars (\$177,000.00)**.

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines and in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (November 2008), National Contracts Commission, Sub-Section No. S-2040
