1. The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the **INNER CITY BASIC SERVICES FOR THE POOR PROJECT**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the following Contract:

2. The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Federal Gardens Multi-Purpose Building- Perimeter Fencing & External Works in St Andrew**. The scope of works consists of construction of approximately 300m in length x 2m overall height perimeter wall comprising of 25mm flat iron grillwork 7.2m x 0.6m in sections and double-leaf metal gate with pedestrian gate, construction of 20m² square of bathroom facilities with the necessary finishes sanitary fittings and electrical works . The delivery/construction period is four (4) months.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Building Construction**” **Grade 4 or higher**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).

Bids **shall** be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One Hundred and Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000.00)**.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines and in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (November 2008), National Contracts Commission, Sub-Section No. S-2040

Bid Collection period is **Wednesday, December 2, 2009 to Wednesday, January 6, 2010 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m.** A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Two Thousand Five Hundred Jamaican Dollars (JMD2,500.00)** for printed copy or **Five Hundred Jamaican Dollars (JMD500.00)** for Compact Disc (CD) in cash or certified cheque made payable to the Jamaica Social Investment Fund. **All bids must be submitted in printed copy. Original and Copy of the bid must be submitted in accordance with Instruction to Bidders.**

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before **Thursday, January 7, 2010 at 12:00 noon.** Electronic bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically on **Thursday, January 7, 2010** in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at **12:05 p.m.**
