GROVE PRIMARY SCHOOL – HURRICANE DEAN – ST. ANDREW (#71879)

2. The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Grove Primary School – Hurricane Dean in St. Andrew**. The works involve constructing a replacement building as a stand alone plywood structure adjacent to administrative block, repair and replace wooden connecting wall, installing of drain covers on indoor drains and the repair of leaking roof. The delivery/construction period is **Three (3) months**.

The works involve demolition and alteration works, execution of repairs to timber-framing roof and to ply-board ceiling. Supply and installation of doors. Execution of electrical and plumbing works, construction of a tank base and tank installation. Painting of the building. The delivery/construction period is **Three (3) months**.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for **Watermount Health Centre – Hurricane Dean in St. Catherine**. The works involve demolition of existing roof and ceiling, replacing roof with alu-steel sheeting. Supply and installation of doors, construction of a sanitation block. Replacing damage bathroom fixtures and painting of the building. Execution of minor electrical and plumbing works. The delivery/construction period is **Three (3) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category “**Building Construction**” in **Grade 4 or higher Grades**. (See www.ocg.gov.jm).
