The European Union (EU) through the 9th European Development Fund (EDF) and the Government of Jamaica (GOJ) will fund the Poverty Reduction Programme II (PRP II). The Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF) is the implementing agency for the PRP II. The purpose of the programme is the improvement in socio-economic conditions and quality of life in communities with emphasis on the promotion of community safety and the reduction of criminal behaviour in volatile and vulnerable communities. Specifically, the PRP II will improve the living conditions of the poor by providing access to quality basic infrastructure and services.

The Government of Jamaica intends to apply a part of the proceeds of this grant to cover payments under the following contracts :

Harbour Road Rehabilitation – Kingston (072251)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Harbour Road Rehabilitation**. The work involves the rehabilitation of **0.8 km** of roadway to include earthworks, cleaning, scarifying, shaping, grading and compacting of road way. Construction of drains including a curb and a channel, a concrete cross drain and an asphaltic concrete cross drain. Repairs to the existing side walk. The construction period is **four (4) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category “**General Road Works**” in **Grade 3 or higher grades**.

Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One Hundred and Forty Eight Thousand Dollars (\$148,000.00)**.

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Called to Excellence Basic School Completion**. The works involves the completion of the school to include construction of wheel chair ramp and stairs to rear classroom doors, completion of plumbing and electrical works, painting, installation of partitions and construction of play area and new kitchen. The construction period is **four (4) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category “**Building Construction**” in **Grade 4 or higher grades**.

Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)**.

Melrose Primary & Junior High School Rehabilitation and Fencing – St. Andrew (#072241)

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Melrose Primary & Junior High School Rehabilitation and Fencing**. The works involves the rehabilitation of the school to include construction of a changing room, completion of plumbing and electrical works, painting, installation of partitions, removal and installation of a new roof for the Home Economics building. Construction of a perimeter wall fencing. The construction period is **four (4) months**.

All national bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) in the category **“Building Construction”** in **Grade 3 or higher grades**.

Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **One Hundred and Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$175,000.00)**.
