#### **Little Lane Lord of Mercy Basic School – Hurricane Dean – St. Catherine (#71841)**

The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the *INNER CITY BASIC SERVICES FOR THE POOR PROJECT*, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the following Contract.

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the proposed **Little Lane Lord of Mercy Basic School – Hurricane Dean – St. Catherine**. The project will involve roof and ceiling bed repairs, remedial electrical works over an area of approx. 154m<sup>2</sup>. Included also are improvement to the main building entrance and the entrance gate. External works include landscaping and perimeter block wall reconstruction. The construction period is **Two (2) Months**.

Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans*, Revised October 2006 and the Government of Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (May 2001) and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries as defined in the World Bank guidelines. Selective Tendering (Local Advertising) procedures and guidelines specified in the Government of Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (May 2001), National Contracts Commission, Sections 3 and 6 will be used.
