Poverty Reduction Programme II (PRP II)

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF) through funding from the European Union and the Government of Jamaica invites Community Based Organisations (CBOs) to apply for funding for through the Grants of Low Amount (GOLA) Scheme.

Eligible CBOs must:

- be a legally registered CBO in Jamaica
- have been in operation for at least one year
- be engaged in providing capacity building and development support services to communities
- apply using the GOLA application package available at the JSIF and SDC offices OR on the JSIF, Planning Institute of Jamaica (PIOJ) and European Union (EU) websites: www.jsif.org, www.pioj.gov.jm and www.deljam.ec.europa.eu
