The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development towards the cost of the INTEGRATED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (ICDP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to cover payments under the following contract:

Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the **ICDP - Procurement for the Supply of Two (2) Tyre Shredders for the National Solid Waste Management Authority**. The scope of works involves the supply and delivery on site of:

1. Two (2) tyre shredders in accordance with the Technical Specification in the bidding document.
2. Provision of Training for NWSMA Staff who will use the machines
3. Provision of maintenance services for 24 months.
4. The delivery/installation period is **Four (4) months**.

All Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the category **“Industrial, Construction Equipment and Machinery”** (see www.ocg.gov.jm). **Failure to include National Contracts Commission Certificate/Letter with bid will result in disqualification.**

2. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines and the Government of Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (Revised March 17, 2014), Volume 2 of 4 Procedures for the Procurement of Goods, General Services & Works.

4. All Bidders must be tax compliant at bid opening. **Failure to include Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) with bid will result in disqualification.**

5. Bids MUST be accompanied by Bid Security in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Jamaican Dollars (J\$100,000.00).
