CONSULTANTS TO CARRY OUT DESIGN AND SUPERVISION SERVICES FOR CIVIL & INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF) was established in 1996 as a component of the Government of Jamaica's strategy to reduce poverty. The Fund promotes, appraises, finances and supervises social and economic infrastructure projects, including schools, roads, agro-processing, water, sanitation, health centres, community centres, homes for children and the elderly, as well as, vocational skills training, counselling, parenting, life education and organizational strengthening.

This exercise seeks to increase the pool of Consulting Firms available to the JSIF for the design and supervision of civil and infrastructure works undertaken by the organization. In general, Consulting Firms are required to liaise with multiple stakeholders (including community members and Agencies of Government) to ensure that infrastructure needs which support the delivery of basic services are designed and delivered effectively and meet all applicable regulations and standards. JSIF's scope of works include *inter alia*:

- Construction and Rehabilitation of:
 - Schools (Basic & Primary Schools)
 - Health Centres
 - Community Spaces (Centres, Green Spaces, Multipurpose Courts)
 - Other Public Buildings
- Rehabilitation of Roads
 - Main and Minor Arterial Roads
 - Urban roads and footpaths
 - Drainage, Erosion Control Structures and Retaining Walls
 - Storm Water Conveyance Systems
- Construction and Rehabilitation of Urban and Rural Water Supply Systems
- Sewage Network and Disposal Systems
- Water Network and Pump Stations
- Electrical /Lighting Installation
- Energy Conservation and Renewable Systems
- Other Civil and Infrastructure Works

Expressions of Interest are now invited from suitably qualified Firms comprising the following skill sets:

- Project Manager
- Architect (Lead Architect must be registered with the Architects Registration Board (ARB))
- Engineer (Civil/Structural/Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing) (Engineer must be registered with the Professional Engineers Registration Board (PERB))
- Quantity Surveyor
- Clerk of Works

Consultancy Firms meeting the requirements will be shortlisted for selection in accordance with the Government of Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procedures (Revised March 2014), volume 3 of 4 Procedures for the Procurement of Consulting Services. Complete details of the selection process will be provided to the shortlisted Consultants at the point at which specific services are being tendered.

Interested Consultancy Firms must provide a company profile outlining their qualification(s), professional certification (s) for the company and personnel, associated registration(s) with professional bodies (e.g. PERB and ARB), experiences in undertaking similar assignments and necessary skills and expertise to deliver the relevant services.
