The Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF) was established in 1996 as a component of the Government of Jamaica's strategy to reduce poverty. The Fund promotes, appraises, finances and supervises social and economic infrastructure projects, including schools, roads, agro-processing, water, sanitation, health centres, community centres, homes for children and the elderly, as well as, vocational skills training, counselling, parenting, life education and organizational strengthening.

The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the World Bank towards the cost of the **INTEGRATED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (ICDP),** and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to cover payments under the following contract.

Bid No. 131 - PROCUREMENT OF ONE (1) PICK UP

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the **Procurement of one (1)-Pick up Double Cab.** The scope of tender opportunity includes the supply and delivery on site: One (1) Pick Up Double Cab – current year of the latest model. The delivery period is a maximum three (3) months

All Bidders must be tax compliant at bid opening and a valid **Tax Compliance Certificate** (**TCC**) and proof of current registration with the **National Contracts Commission** (**NCC**) in the category "**Motor Vehicles and Spares**" are required. These documents must be submitted with the bid. (see www.ncc.gov.jm).

1.Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines Procurement of Goods, Works, and Non-Consulting Services: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits (January 2011), and is opened to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines.
