The Fund promotes, appraises, finances and supervises social and economic infrastructure projects, including but not limited to schools, roads, agro-processing, water sanitation, health centres, community centres, scholarship programmes, internships, and capacity building training.

Expressions of Interest (EOI) are now invited from private sector institutions and non-governmental organizations for the provision of training services

to young adults from these target communities.

Organizations responding to this EOI must provide the following:

- Detailed company profile with proof of registration/legal status
- Information on organizational structure and management
- Demonstrable proof of capability in providing training services in the area of Entertainment and Events Management to include Event Planning & Management, Event Logistics & Coordination, Event Mapping & Design, Audio Engineering, Video Engineering & Production, Lighting & Visual Engineering, Wedding Planning, Event Styling and set design.
- Other training components, in the specified area, identified by any organization justified by the opportunities they represent for employment of the beneficiaries are welcome.

The Service Provider will be responsible for routine supervision of trainees, including submission of attendance registers and performance reviews as well as the provision of a meal and the management of transportation logistics. The Service Provider will also be expected to facilitate placement for the trainees either through short term job placement, Internship or permanent shop placement.

Please note that only organizations with offices in the parishes listed above will be considered and while we welcome all applications we can only commit to contacting applicants shortlisted.
