# **INVITATION FOR BIDS**

## JAMAICA DISASTER VULNERABILITY REDUCTION PROJECT (JDVRP)

#### Loan No. 8581 JM

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF) was established in 1996 as a component of the Government of Jamaica's strategy to reduce poverty. The Fund promotes, appraises, finances and supervises social and economic infrastructure projects, including schools, roads, agro-processing, water, sanitation, health centres, community centres, homes for children and the elderly, as well as, vocational skills training, counselling, parenting, life education and organizational strengthening.

The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the World Bank towards the cost of the JAMAICA DISASTER VULNERABILITY REDUCTION PROJECT (JDVRP). The Jamaica Social Investment Fund as the executing agency in collaboration with the Ministry of Local Government and Community Development and the Jamaica Fire Brigade; intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to cover payments under the following contract:

## PORT MARIA FIRE STATION CONSTRUCTION - ST. MARY (#073523)

The scope of works includes but is not limited to the construction of a new fire station comprising three (3) single storey structures housing fire-fighting equipment, engine bays, dormitories, administrative and training facilities. In addition to meeting the building code the facility will be constructed to (1) withstand the multitude of natural disasters, particularly storm surge. (2) to be as energy efficient as possible. The building is of reinforced concrete column and beam construction. *Construction period is Twelve (12) Months.* 

Bids MUST be accompanied by Bid Security in the amount of One Hundred and Twenty – five Thousand Jamaican Dollars (J\$125,000.00).

1. All national Bidders must be registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) at the time of bid opening in the categories "Civil Engineering" in Grade 1 AND/OR "Building Construction" in Grade 1. International bidders must be registered with the NCC prior to award of contract. (See <a href="http://www.ncc.gov.jm/ncc">www.ncc.gov.jm/ncc</a>).

2. All national Bidders must be tax compliant at bid opening and a valid **Tax Compliance Certificate** (**TCC**) or **Tax Compliance Letter** (**TCL**) **must be included in your Bid. International bidders will be required to obtain a valid TCC prior to award of contract.** (See <u>www.jamaicatax.gov.jm</u>)

3. Bidding will be conducted through the *National Competitive Bidding (NCB)* procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines Procurement of Goods, Works, and Non-Consulting Services: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits (January 2011), and is opened to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the guidelines.
