INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Government of Jamaica established the Jamaica Social Investment Fund Project (JSIF) to assist in its poverty eradication programme. The Government now intends to apply part of the funds it has provided the JSIF, to cover payment under the contract for Greenwich Town Sidewalk and Zinc Fence Substitution - Kingston.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund invites eligible Bidders to submit **Bids** for **Greenwich Town Sidewalk and Zinc Fence Substitution - Kingston**.

Scope:

The Contractor to carry out works in the Greenwich Town Community, Kingston, to include rehabilitation of approximately 1900m (6,234ft.) of sidewalk of width 1.52m (5ft.) and thickness 150mm (6 inches) and the removal and substitution of 300m (984ft.) of zinc fencing with concrete wall comprising of 1.22m (4ft.) masonry block work and 600m (2ft.) decorative blocks, total height of 1.83m (6ft.).
