REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received funding from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in the amount of \$6,696,000 towards the cost of the Basic Needs Trust Fund Eleventh Cycle (BNTF 11). The Jamaica Social Investment Fund as the Executing Agency intends to apply part of the proceeds of this Grant to cover payments under contract for which this invitation is issued. Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of GOJ and upon approval by CDB and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. The Financing Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOJ shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund, the Executing Agency, now wishes to procure Consultancy Services for the Design and Supervision for Dromily Agriculture Cooperative Rural Road Rehabilitation.

This objective of the consultancy is to provide design and supervision services for the rehabilitation of the sub-base, base course and wearing surface along with the construction of the associated curb and channel and other drainage systems to preserve the roadway from further degradation.

The duration of the assignment is **twenty-one (21) months**.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund now invites interested eligible Consulting Firms to submit Expressions of Interest for the provision of these consultancy services.

Consultants shall be eligible to participate if:

- (a) in the case of a body corporate, it is legally incorporated or otherwise organised in an eligible country, has its principal place of business in an eligible country and is more than 50 per cent beneficially owned by citizen(s) and/or *bona fide* resident(s) of eligible country(ies) or by a body(ies) corporate meeting these requirements;
- (b) in the case of unincorporated firms, the persons are citizens or *bona fide* residents of an eligible country; and
- (c) in all cases, the Consultant has no arrangement and undertakes not to make any arrangements, whereby any substantial part of the net profits or other tangible benefits of the contract will accrue or be paid to a person not a citizen or *bona fide* resident of an eligible country.

Eligible countries are member countries of the CDB.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to the Procurement Policy for Projects Financed by CDB (2019) and the Procurement Procedures for Project Financed by CDB (January 2021).

In the assessment of submissions, consideration will be given to organisational capability, general experience, specific experience, human resource availability and experience in the regions. All information must be submitted in English.

A Consultancy Firm will be selected using the **Quality and Cost-Based Selection** method in accordance with the procedures set out in the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) Procurement Procedures for Project Financed CDB (2021).

Eligible Consultancy Firms are invited to submit Expressions of Interest for Consultancy Services for Dromily Agriculture Cooperative Rural Road Rehabilitation.

Only the selected firms who has been short listed shall be asked to submit a technical and financial proposal and, if such proposal is responsive and acceptable, be invited to negotiate a contract.
