Targeting Agri-Business and Community Tourism Enterprises For Matching Grant Support



Jamaica Social Investment Fund (JSIF) on behalf of the Government of Jamaica with funding through a loan from the World Bank invites applications for business proposals that may qualify for technical assistance for business plan development, and eventually to co-financing or matching grant support under the Second Rural Economic Development Initiative (REDI II) project under Component 1:

Climate Resilient Agriculture and Community Tourism Investments for Rural Enterprises for activities including, but not limited to the following:

- □ Health, Safety and Security Measures
- Uvirtual, Digital or Technology Enhanced Products, Marketing or Service Delivery
- □ Value Added Production and Equipment
- Community Tourism Enterprises and Clusters (Attractions, Agro-Tourism, Nature- or Eco-Tourism, Cultural Heritage Tourism)
- Local Forest Management Committees or Protected Areas
- Technology-Based Activities that Support and Showcase Agriculture and Community Tourism
- Technical Assistance and Capacity Building
- Tour Operators that Demonstrate Collaboration with Community Tourism Enterprises
- Groups Fisheries Development (e.g., equipment and fish cleaning or filleting facility) or Special Fisheries Conservation Groups
- □ Introduction of Alternative Energy Sources (solar panels) to improve production efficiency and reduce energy costs
- □ Introduction of New Crop Varieties and Innovative Production Methods
- Dest-harvest Facilities / Cold Storage Infrastructure
- Water Harvesting and Drip Irrigation Systems

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applications should be from **registered organizations** e.g., Community Based Organizations (CBOs), Cooperatives, Benevolent Societies, Non-Governmental Organisations, Tour Operators or other Limited Liability Companies, Tourism Cluster Associations, Producer Organisations

NB: Applications from individuals and private companies are encouraged once collaboration between communities and the private enterprise can be established

- 2. Proposed projects must have an **identified and defined market** and demonstrate **economic & financial feasibility** and have the potential to enhance **climate resilience**
- 3. Applying groups must have a composition of at least 40% women and/or 30% youth
- **4.** Applications that request construction or rehabilitation of a building **must** attach to the application form a copy of proof of ownership, or lease agreement (*please see Section 2.16 of the Application Guidelines for further details on the minimum period of Land Tenure*)
- 5. Applying groups must contribute between 5% to 50% of amount being requested in cash or in kind
